DOG-A-POOL-OOZA RULES

Please be advised that this is a dog-friendly event. Participants will encounter dogs in various conditions (i.e. wet, unleashed, etc.). For the safety of everyone and every dog, all participants must comply with the Dogapoolooza rules.

Dog waste must be cleaned up and properly disposed.

All dogs must be under handler's control, even when off-leash. Uncontrollable dogs may be asked to be restrained.

Each handler is limited to no more than 2 dogs.

Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

No dogs under 4-months old.

Vaccinations required, including rabies and bordatella (Kennel Cough).

Due to Health Department restrictions, only dogs will be allowed in the water.

Please leave collar on dog while swimming.

Please respect designated "small dog only" areas.

All non-exhibiting dogs must be on leashes while at the "Demonstration Only" area.

Open swim for dogs is allowed in the shallow end of the outdoor pool only.

Do not push or throw dogs into the water.

We recommend offering your dog fresh water frequently. There are drinking stations located on the pool deck. Do NOT allow dogs to drink from pool.

Please note that the deck can become very slippery when wet.

Please monitor your dog's health and comfort. If dogs become overheated, there is a cooling station at the veterinary center.

A rinse station is provided at the NW corner of the building. We recommend you rinse your dog after swimming.
